The PXIe/700 is a modular pluggable card, based on the PXI standard which has been around since 1997. PXI adopts the rugged CompactPCI form factor and adds integrated clocks, triggers, and synchronization critical to test and measurement applications.



FMC is an abbreviation for FPGA Mezzanine Cards, standardized in 2010 as VITA 57.1. By standardizing the mechanical footprint and electrical interface, FMC cards can host a wide range of analog, digital, RF, and IO functions to then be deployed onto a carrier board.
