

RoHS, REACH, PFAS, POPs, and Additional Environmental Compliance Declaration

Sundance Multiprocessor Technology Limited (Sundance) is dedicated to serving you by providing high-quality products that meet environmental regulations, including restrictions on hazardous substances (RoHS), UK Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals (REACH), new Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) requirements, the UN Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), and the additional environmental regulations listed in this declaration. We are providing you with the following information to assist you in meeting your environmental policies and procedures.

RoHS Compliance

Sundance produces products that are RoHS 3 compliant. RoHS (Directive 2011/65/EU as amended by 2015/863/EU) restricts ten hazardous substances. These substances are not present in finished Sundance products above the permitted threshold limits unless covered by exemptions under the RoHS Directive. Sundance cannot guarantee that inventory held by distributors or other third parties is RoHS compliant.

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)**	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)***	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)***	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)***	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)***	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)

*Except when allowed by the Directive, for example: 3500 ppm in steel, 4000 ppm in aluminium alloys, and 40000 ppm in copper alloys.

**DecaBDE is included in the PBDE group and restricted at the same threshold.

***The restriction of DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP applies to all products since 22 July 2019. Exemptions for certain medical devices and monitoring instruments applied until 22 July 2021 but have since expired.

The compliance of Sundance products with RoHS is monitored and maintained by:

1. Controlling the materials and finishes used in our products.
2. Carrying out periodic analysis of our products when required.

UK REACH Compliance

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations for companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles. Following the UK's departure from the EU, we now operate under "UK REACH". The rules are broadly the same but are managed separately by the UK regulator, the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).

- Under the structure of the UK REACH Regulations, Sundance is a manufacturer and supplier of "articles" to our customers. We do not manufacture or supply "substances" or "preparations", and our articles do not involve the intentional release of substances. Accordingly, we foresee no registration or pre-registration requirement for the products we supply to you.
- Sundance believes that even though UK REACH is a UK regulation, our products are affected in all geographical regions. Therefore, Sundance applies UK REACH requirements worldwide.
- Sundance monitors the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) in our products, as defined by UK REACH. This is an ongoing process since the Candidate List is updated in stages.
- Customers are encouraged to visit the relevant HSE site for the most up-to-date information on the current list of SVHCs under UK REACH: [UK REACH Candidate List of substances of very high concern \(SVHCs\) for authorisation - HSE](#)
- Customers are encouraged to visit the relevant ECHA site for the most up-to-date information on the current list of SVHCs under EU REACH: [Candidate List of substances of very high concern for Authorisation - ECHA](#)
- Sundance products (articles) do not contain SVHCs above the threshold limit value of 0.1% w/w, in line with the ECHA Candidate List (253 SVHCs as of February 2026) and the current UK REACH Candidate List.
- Environmental regulations change constantly. We will periodically update this letter to keep you informed of changes that affect Sundance products.

PFAS Compliance

Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) are a group of synthetic chemicals that are highly persistent in the environment and can accumulate in living organisms. Because of their persistence and potential risks to health and the environment, PFAS are under increasing regulatory control in the UK and EU.

In the UK, PFAS are regulated under UK REACH. The Health and Safety Executive (HSE) has identified PFAS as a priority in the UK REACH Rolling Action Plan for 2025-2027 and is assessing possible restriction measures.

Certain PFAS, including perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS), and perfluorohexane sulfonic acid (PFHxS), are already restricted under UK law through the POPs Regulation.

In the EU, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) is evaluating a group-wide PFAS restriction proposal submitted by five Member States (Denmark, Germany, the Netherlands, Norway and Sweden). The process is ongoing.

Sundance has reviewed the materials used in our products. Sundance products (articles) do not contain PFAS above the threshold limit values set by UK or EU law.

POPs Compliance

The UN Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) is an international treaty that aims to eliminate or restrict the production and use of hazardous chemicals that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms, and pose risks to human health and ecosystems.

The Sundance logo is located in the top right corner. It consists of a yellow-to-orange gradient semi-circle with the word "SUNDANCE" in bold, black, uppercase letters.

The UK enforces compliance with these requirements through the retained POPs Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, as amended). Other substances such as PFOA, PFOS and PFHxS remain restricted with limited exemptions. Sundance is committed to meeting these standards. We have reviewed Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS), supplier documentation and material information where applicable and confirm that our products do not contain substances classified as POPs above regulatory thresholds.

As a small company, Sundance relies on practical due diligence and supplier documentation to support compliance. This review process, aligned with UK environmental regulations, provides confidence that POPs are not present in our products.

Sundance continues to monitor regulatory changes and remains committed to maintaining high standards of product safety and environmental responsibility. This ongoing process supports our commitment to compliant, safe products and to wider environmental and public health goals.

Additional Regulatory Declarations

The following declarations are provided in response to specific customer requirements. Sundance products are finished electronic articles. The statements below apply to products supplied directly by Sundance and do not apply to products modified by customers or by other third parties.



SUNDANCE

Ozone-Depleting Substances (ODS) Regulation (EU) 2024/590

Regulation (EU) 2024/590 controls ozone-depleting substances and products or equipment containing those substances or whose functioning relies upon those substances.

Sundance products do not contain, use, release, or rely on ozone-depleting substances for their operation. Sundance products are not refrigeration, air-conditioning, heat pump, fire protection, foam-blown, or gas-containing equipment of the type normally associated with ozone-depleting substance controls.

Fluorinated Greenhouse Gases (F-GHG / F-Gas) Regulation (EU) 2024/573

Regulation (EU) 2024/573 controls fluorinated greenhouse gases and products or equipment containing or relying upon those gases.

Sundance products do not contain, use, release, or rely on fluorinated greenhouse gases for their operation. Sundance products are not refrigeration, air-conditioning, heat pump, switchgear, fire protection, or gas-containing equipment of the type normally associated with fluorinated greenhouse gas controls.

Mercury Regulation (EU) 2017/852

Regulation (EU) 2017/852 controls the use and storage of, and trade in, mercury, mercury compounds, mixtures of mercury, mercury-added products and mercury waste.

Sundance products are not mercury-added products. Sundance products do not intentionally contain mercury or mercury compounds. Mercury is also restricted under RoHS for electrical and electronic equipment, as stated in the RoHS Compliance section of this declaration.

Radioactive Substances - Council Directive 2013/59/Euratom

Council Directive 2013/59/Euratom lays down basic safety standards for protection against the dangers arising from exposure to ionising radiation.

Sundance products do not contain radioactive substances, sealed radioactive sources, radioactive materials, or components intended to emit ionising radiation.

Biocidal Products Regulation (EU) No 528/2012

Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 applies to biocidal products and treated articles.

Sundance products are not biocidal products. Sundance does not intentionally treat its products with biocidal products, intentionally incorporate biocidal products into its products, or make antibacterial, antimicrobial, anti-mould, disinfecting, preserving, pest control, or other biocidal claims for its products.
